Hiremech Ltd is a forklift truck company based in Tottenham, North London, offering new and refurbished forklifts for sale, maintenance of forklifts and forklift truck driver training. They also hire forklifts on a flexible basis, short or long term, with or without a driver. The company was established in 1996 and the turnover has reached £3m. They have been based in Haringey since 1999 and hold the main market share in North and Greater London.

Hiremech Ltd have also just introduced the first completely electric commercial vehicle into London. The van is congestion charge free, emission free and can be charged on a 13 amp plug. Hiremech have invested in ten vehicles for short term hire and demonstration purposes.

North London Business first met Paul Green, MD of Hiremech in 2005 and since then, has supported them on a variety of projects. Hiremech had been trying for some time to become a government funded training provider and to this end underwent City and Guilds accreditation to NVQ2 level for their courses, which were already industry-standard to RTITB standards. They achieved this in June 2007 and around the same time, NLB arranged to put them in touch with KIS Training, a Tottenham-based Learning and Skills Council training consortium where they successfully bid for a year's contract to deliver NVQ2 Forklift training to 800 individuals over 350 courses. They will begin to deliver this contract in September 2007 and the contract will enable them to offer free training to tens of large distributors and manufacturers in the area who they have already been in contact with, as well as individuals referred from KIS training.

NLB has also introduced Hiremech to a local multinational drinks distributor, who had previously mentioned their interest in working with high calibre local companies, and were invited to put in an expression of interest for a hire contract.



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
